### BURGUNDY

In Burgundy, 'Fleur de Lys' cruises the Canal du Centre, River Saône and Burgundy Canal.

Running through the Côte Chalonnaise, a region of vineyards, orchards and dairy farms, the **Canal du Centre** crosses a hilly terrain that offers excellent views of the Burgundian landscape. Built in the 18th century, it was the final link in the first inland waterway between the English Channel and the Mediterranean Sea. Today it is a charming route for leisurely barge cruises.

Passing small French villages and riverside towns, the **River Saône** links the Canal du Centre with the Burgundy Canal,

one of the prettiest and most popular waterways in France.

More than 150 miles in length, the **Burgundy Canal** took more than 100 years to build and has over 200 locks. It meanders through a wondrous area of romantic villages, historic abbeys and elegant châteaux.

Here, in the heart of Burgundy — France’s most famous wine-producing region — guests aboard ‘Fleur de Lys’ enjoy many opportunities to sample the local vintages and enjoy the good life.
